Miguel es **tan fuerte como** Ud.  
Las chicas son **tan altas como** yo.

Miguel is as strong as you (you are).  
The girls are as tall as me (I am).

tanto/a/os/as noun como = as much/many \_\_\_\_\_ as

***\*\*use the form of tanto/a/os/as to agree with the noun***

Tengo **tanto dinero como** Juan.  
Leemos **tantos libros como** tú.

I have as much money as Juan (has).  
We read as many books as you (read).
