

TÚ COMMANDS

- Used with friends, family, pets, & your peers
- Positive commands tell the person **to do** something
- Negative commands tell the person **not to do** something

To form a positive command:

Use the present tense _____ form of the verb.

Exs: Talk to the boy! *¡Habla al chico!*
 Read the book! *¡Lee el libro!*
 Write the story! *¡Escribe el cuento!*

**If the verb is a stem changer, it will change in the positive command!

Ex. - Start the test! *¡Empieza el examen!*

Irregular Positive Tú Commands

Decir →	Di	Say/Tell	Poner →	Pon	Put/Place/Set
Tener →	Ten	Have	Hacer →	Haz	Do/Make
Salir →	Sal	Leave	Valer →	Val	Be worth
Ir →	Ve	Go	Ser →	Sé	Be
Venir →	Ven	Come			

To form a negative command:

Go to the present tense _____ form of the verb.

1. Drop the _____
2. Add the _____
(For -ar verbs add "es" but for -er/-ir verbs add "as")

Exs: Don't talk to the boy! *¡No hables al chico!*
 Don't read the book! *¡No leas el libro!*
 Don't write the story! *¡No escribas el cuento!*

Irregular Negative Tú Commands

Dar →	No des	Don't give	Ir →	No vayas	Don't go
Estar →	No estés	Don't be	Saber →	No sepas	Don't know
Ser →	No seas	Don't be
